Bacco - Four Seasons - Nashville, TN



The Challenge

Bacco, the upcoming flagship restaurant at Four Seasons Hotel and Private Residences Nashville, is designed as an immersive hospitality destination that blends Tuscan-inspired warmth with the energy of downtown Nashville. The concept includes three distinct environments within one venue, a bar and lounge, an all-seasons terrazza, and an intimate dining room. The lighting and controls strategy needed to support these layered spaces and allow smooth transitions between daytime, evening, and late-night use. Integration with motorized pergola systems and Somfy shade control was required to manage comfort and daylight conditions across the terrazza and interior spaces.

The Solution

A BubblyNet lighting control system was implemented using 0–10V and phase dimming control to deliver smooth, responsive lighting transitions throughout the restaurant. Motorized pergola systems and Somfy shade controls were fully integrated into the same platform, enabling coordinated adjustment of daylight, shading, and artificial lighting across the terrazza and interior spaces. This unified approach allows the environment to shift effortlessly between open-air vibrancy and intimate dining conditions while preserving visual comfort and design intent. The result is a highly adaptable hospitality environment that enhances guest experience through seamless control of light, shade, and atmosphere.
